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Upcoming In-Service Workshop Focuses on Grant Writing

YORKTOWN HEIGHTS – Educators wanting to enhance their grant-writing skills will benefit from an upcoming in-service workshop. Grant Writing for All, designed to give an overview of the grant writing process, is being offered by the Hudson River Teacher Center at Putnam/Northern Westchester BOCES' Yorktown Campus.

In-service workshop participants will develop the skills to create a successful grant proposal. Topics include: larger grants, completing grant applications, and resources for finding grants and writing grant proposals.

This in-service workshop targets educators at all grade levels including regular and special education teachers, administrators, and guidance counselors. Jim Desimone, technology director at Blythedale, will be the presenter.

The training will be offered on November 5, November 12, November 19, and December 3. All courses will be held from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the projects conference room of P/NW BOCES' Projects Building. (The December 3 training will be held in the North Conference Room of the School Services Building.)

The cost for HRTC-member district participants is \$10 per session, or \$50 per non-member district participants. Registration deadline is October 22. In-service credit is based on district policy.
